

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Tuesday 07 Feb 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mainly bright in northern UK, with much of the south improving later as areas of freezing fog and low cloud progressively clear in the raw easterly breeze. Becoming breezier and less cold in the far northwest overnight with some rain, although it will be dry and very cold for most with clear spells allowing a widespread hard frost.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Mainly clear, crisp and very cold on Wednesday, although a little cloudier in the far south and east at times. It will be less cold but windy in the far northwest, with spells of rain; these conditions later edging southeastwards into Thursday.
