Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Eastern counties of England and parts of northeast Scotland will be largely dry at first before cloud and outbreaks of rain spread from western parts during the morning and afternoon. It remains largely cloudy overnight with further rain in many places, although some parts of England may see drier conditions by dawn tomorrow. Becoming breezy at times.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Some sunny spells, but with scattered showers on Saturday, these possibly merging to give longer spells of rain at times across England and Wales. Drier on Sunday with more sunny periods, although rain may affect Northern Ireland and western Scotland later.
