Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Most places will be dry with sunny spells, although there will be some showery rain in parts of southeastern England and also a scattering of showers across Scotland, especially in the west. It will be noticeably cooler compared to Tuesday across southeastern England and East Anglia, especially near the Norfolk coast.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Both Thursday and Friday will be dry with sunny spells once any early misty patches have dispersed. It will be chilly during the nights and early mornings, although the afternoons will be quite warm in most locations. Winds, mainly light in strength, except in the far south of England.
