

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A sunny, albeit frosty start in the south. Cloudier elsewhere with some patchy rain at times. The cloud will slowly spread south through the day, with patchy rain continuing across northern parts. However, a few showers may develop in the south and east. Remaining generally cloudy overnight with outbreaks of light rain at times.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

A rather cool day on Saturday, particularly across some eastern areas. Largely cloudy across the UK, with some patchy light rain at times, especially across northwestern parts. Some brighter spells developing elsewhere. Mostly cloudy with patchy rain on Sunday, turning more persistent in the northwest later.
