

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 1945 on Saturday 04 Feb 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Sunday will start with a widespread risk of ice and some areas of fog. The remainder of the band of rain, sleet and snow that affected the country on Saturday will ease and clear southeastern Britain during the morning, with eastern UK then becoming generally dry. Rain will soon spread into western parts however, coupled with some hill snow.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A northwest-southeast split should develop into the new working week, with northern and western areas becoming less cold with spells of rain and some hill snow. Meanwhile eastern and especially southeastern parts of the UK should be drier, clearer and colder.
