General Situation

A weakening cold front will edge slowly and erratically southwards across the United Kingdom, reaching southern England on Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest, becoming cyclonic later, 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 at times in Moray Firth.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in north.

Showers, thundery later.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, becoming north 4 or 5, backing northwest 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 later.

Smooth or slight in east, moderate in north, becoming moderate or rough.

Thundery showers then rain.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north 4 or 5 for a time.

Mainly slight.

Rain with fog patches, becoming mainly fair.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming west or northwest 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate, and moderate or rough later in north.

Thundery showers, then occasional rain.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor, in north.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming north 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Mainly slight.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North backing west 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later, becoming variable 3 for a time.

Slight, becoming moderate later in north.

Showers.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

Variable, mainly northwest, 3 or 4.

Fog patches, occasional rain later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Variable 3 or less becoming mainly easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

Variable 3 or less.

Variable 3 at first in Bristol Channel, otherwise northeasterly, 3 or 4,

increasing 5 at times.

24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less becoming northerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 around western headlands.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 around western headlands.
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.
Mainly fair.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

Northwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times in west and south.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.
Occasional rain for a time.
Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Northwesterly 4 or 5.
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.
Mainly fair.

Northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times in North Channel.
Smooth or slight at first in south, otherwise slight or moderate.
Rain at first.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in North Channel.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near headlands.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at first, showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Shallow low developing to the west of Shetland sinks south, with associated fronts affecting Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

West backing south or southeast, occasionally variable, 3 or 4.

Slight to moderate.

Mainly fair, some rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Saturday 06 Sep until 1200 UTC on Saturday 06 Sep:

Variable 3 or 4. becoming northeasterly 4 or 5 in the west.

Slight to moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to north 1 to 3, veering east overnight.

Smooth or slight.

Fair some mist patches developing overnight, clearing slowly tomorrow.

Moderate to poor, becoming locally good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or variable 1 to 3.

Smooth or slight.

Fair or cloudy some mist or haze.

Moderate, locally poor.

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
