

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Widespread sleet or snow showers leading to further accumulations in the north this morning, and over hills elsewhere. Showers turning back to rain at low levels through the day. Very windy, with gales in west and feeling cold. Some clear spells overnight, but also occasional wintry outbreaks, with more significant snow showers in the north later. Widespread frost and ice.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wintry showers in the north and east tomorrow. A few showers Irish Sea coasts. Elsewhere becoming drier and brighter into the afternoon. Thursday; wintry showers in the east, otherwise largely dry and bright. Winds will ease, but still feeling cold.
