Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It'll be a dry start to the day, with some patchy frost and fog at first.  
Elsewhere, there'll be some sunny spells, but it'll turn wet and windy from the west. Rain will continue to move eastwards overnight with some hill snow in the north. Clearer conditions will follow to the west with a risk of icy stretches by morning.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
Cloud and occasional rain and drizzle will linger in the far east on Tuesday and Wednesday, whilst further west there'll be sunshine and showers. Some of these showers will be heavy at times on Tuesday, possibly with hail and thunder.
