Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Any remaining showers will gradually ease away through the evening to leave a largely dry night with clear spells. This will lead to it turning chilly, especially in more rural northern areas. A fine and dry day will follow on Monday, with plenty of warm sunny spells. However the odd shower is possible, especially later in the far southwest.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
There will be plenty of fine and dry weather with sunny spells, although isolated showers are still likely. It will be warm in the south, whilst stronger wind and rain will spread into northwestern areas during Wednesday, before spreading south.
