Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
In southern and eastern counties of England, early rain will move away this morning. Otherwise, England and Wales can expect sunny periods with only a few showers near some western coasts, while Scotland and Northern Ireland have sunny intervals and scattered showers, especially in more western and northern regions. During today, some areas will be rather windy with everywhere feeling chilly.  
During tonight, after a mainly fine and dry start, it will turn cloudier with some drizzly rain moving from the southwest.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
It will be unsettled with showers or longer outbreaks of rain, along with some gales.
