Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most places will have a fine day with plenty of warm sunshine, once any early mist and fog clears. However, northern and western Scotland and parts of Northern Ireland will see outbreaks of rain and increasing winds, with severe gales developing later. Overnight, the rain will spread gradually southeast, reaching central parts by dawn.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain will clear slowly from southern Britain on Tuesday, with largely fine and sunny conditions developing to the north. It will, however, remain very windy across northern Scotland. Wednesday will be another fine day for most, with winds easing across the far north.
