

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Chilly at first in the north, though plenty of warm sunshine following today. Cloudier skies further south, with some showery rain, most likely across south-eastern parts. Breezy here, and feeling cold, especially along eastern coasts. Cloud will creep north-westwards overnight, leaving overcast skies for many, accompanied by occasional light rain. Some clear spells in the north, allowing another chilly night.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Fine and dry in the north on Thursday and Friday. Cloudy skies elsewhere, particularly during the mornings with isolated showers at times, but some brighter spells developing later on. Feeling warm in the west, whilst rather cold towards eastern coasts.
