Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Fine for much of England and Wales with sunny skies expected, once mist and fog patches clear. Feeling pleasantly mild in the sunshine with light winds. More cloud elsewhere with some rain affecting western Scotland, later reaching Northern Ireland. Windy for a time across northwest Scotland. Generally dry overnight but becoming frosty over England and Wales with areas of fog.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Fog will be slow to clear on Sunday but most places across England and Wales should eventually see some sunshine. Scotland and Northern Ireland will be rather cloudy but mainly dry. Fine for most on Monday with plenty of sunshine.
