Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Eastern/southeastern and some Central areas, starting cloudy with rain, perhaps some sleet or snow in places, mainly light and gradually clearing away during the morning, although lingering in eastern Scotland. Isolated wintry showers possibly following in the southeast. Elsewhere, largely dry with hazy sun although rain is expected in the northwest later. Rather cold, cold in parts of the north.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Changeable. Starting bright and frosty on Saturday in East Wales and England, otherwise cloudy with some light rain or sleet spreading southeast. More rain spreading to all areas on Sunday, but becoming milder in fresh or strong southwest winds.
