

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 19 Dec 2006

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cold with some sunny spells in eastern Scotland, cloudy and mild in the north and west. Over England and Wales, mist and fog only slowly clearing, perhaps lingering all day in one or two places. Some sunny spells, particularly parts of the southwest. Temperatures will be pegged back where it remains dull.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

High pressure remains well and truly in charge, so it will be dry. Many places continuing to see frost and fog by night, and this could linger through the daytime in some parts. It will be cold where the fog lingers, temperatures near normal in sunnier parts.
