

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Heavy rain and strong winds in south-west England, Wales and northern England will move into Northern Ireland and later into Scotland. In the west, the rain will be replaced by heavy showers but the south-east will stay dry, though breezy. Rain will continue in northern Scotland overnight. Elsewhere, it will be mild with a few heavy showers.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

There will be plenty of sunshine and a few showers tomorrow. Some of the showers will be heavy during the morning, but ease during the afternoon. Heavy rain and stronger winds will push northeastwards on Saturday, though the far south-east may avoid these.
