Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most parts will be dry and sunny, although with easterly winds gusty over hills, particularly the Pennines. Feeling pleasantly warm in brighter western and southern areas. Some locally heavy and thundery showers will develop in southern counties of England and Wales today, then persist in the south this evening and overnight. Dry and clear elsewhere, although misty around northeast Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Most areas will be dry with sunny spells, but cloudier in southern and southwestern England with some thundery showers. Low cloud and mistiness in eastern Scotland. On Tuesday, mainly dry with sunny spells although cloudier in southwest England with showers.
