Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Rain, sleet and hill snow across most southern parts of the UK will continue to move south through the day. Feeling very cold with strong northeasterly winds, perhaps reaching gale force at times in exposure. Cold, but brighter further north, with wintry showers continuing in the north and east.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

A cold start on Thursday, with a frost in many places. Any rain and sleet quickly clearing southwards through the morning. Most places seeing a dry day with large amounts of cloud. Outbreaks of light rain along with milder conditions will slowly push south across the UK Thursday night into Friday.
