

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Monday 25 Dec 2006

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most areas cloudy and dull but apart patchy drizzle, generally dry. However, Scotland will have sunshine but also fog patches, and brighter spells are likely near north facing coasts elsewhere. Mostly rather cold. Tonight, low cloud will continue to keep frost away but also give fog and patchy drizzle. Clearer skies in northeastern Scotland will allow frost and fog patches.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Little change for most on Tuesday. On Wednesday, generally cloudy with an area of moving east then north across most areas, perhaps heavy at times in the west, giving a risk of icy conditions in Scotland later. Generally rather cold.
