Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Dry, bright and warm for many, locally hot in southeastern parts.
Isolated sharp showers are likely over parts of Scotland and perhaps
N Ireland and E England too. Generally dry with clear spells tonight
but with thundery downpours in the southeast later, and very muggy
here too.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Thundery downpours in eastern areas on Saturday, locally torrential
but these clearing later from the south. Rain pushing into N Ireland
and the far SW of England. Elsewhere, mainly dry, fine and warm
again. On Sunday, most places dry, bright and warm, but thundery rain
could linger in the far north of Scotland.
