Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Most of Scotland will have a dry and sunny day after a frosty start. Northern Ireland and Northern England will start fine but a band of persistent rain over Southwest England and South Wales in the morning will spread northeastwards during the day with heavy showers behind.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday stays following unsettled with rain or showers for many places, which could be heavy in southern England. Winds will be light with some sunshine at times. Rain will spread into Western Scotland on Sunday and showers over England should move away to leave most places with a fine day with some sunshine.
