Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain will continue to move eastwards across the country, turning more showery as it does so. Heavy, thundery showers will affect Northern Ireland and much of Scotland, possibly extending into northwest England later tonight. Further rain, heavy at times, is likely to affect much of southern England overnight. Warm in southeast England, but cooler elsewhere.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Further heavy showers are expected from northern England northwards on Tuesday, with another pulse of rain running along the south coast of England. Elsewhere, some sunny spells. Sunshine and showers for many areas on Wednesday. Feeling quite cool with a brisk northwesterly wind.
