Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Thursday:-Scotland starting cloudy with outbreaks of rain, locally heavy/persistent. Somewhat drier conditions, spreading in during the morning. Mainly dry later, perhaps some brightness in the north. N.Ireland/N.England/Wales/Midlands, mostly cloudy with some rain/drizzle, perhaps heavy/persistent for a time. Remaining areas rather cloudy but mainly dry with at least some bright/sunny spells. Temperatures near normal in the wetter north, but feeling cooler in the wind. Rather warm/warm in any sunshine in the south.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Many places dry with increasing amounts of sunshine. Still rather cloudy across northwestern areas with some rain at times. Generally warm, locally very warm. Cooler in the cloudier northwest.
