Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain will clear eastern counties. Otherwise bright with showers, these heavy and blustery over northern and western hills. Becoming drier from the southwest later. Strong, gusty winds, reaching gale force in places. Most areas becoming dry this evening. But some showers continuing in northwest. Further heavy rain will spread to northwest later in the night with very strong southwesterly winds.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

On Monday, heavy rain in north will spread southwards and ease with southeast staying mainly dry and bright. Heavy showers and stormy winds expected later in north. Dry and bright in south on Tuesday, showers and strong winds in north.
