


# National Severe Weather Warning Service



**Chief Forecasters Assessment**  
 A deep depression near Iceland will pull another cold, showery air mass southwards across the region. Showers will be of rain, sleet and snow, with settling largely restricted to roads above 300 m.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Ice**

Valid from **03:00 on Mon, 15th Dec 2014** until **11:00 on Mon, 15th Dec 2014**

Road surface temperatures will fall below zero in many parts as bands of showers move through, falling as snow on hills. The public should be aware of the risk of icy roads.
