

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
South Wales, central and northeast England can expect further falls of snow, with several centimetres of fresh snow accumulating locally in places during the morning. Northern England, Northern Ireland and southern Scotland will also have occasional sleet and snow, although northern Scotland and western Northern Ireland will become drier and brighter. Southern England will have occasional rain or sleet.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday, much of southern, central and eastern England will have further outbreaks of rain, sleet and snow, although drier and brighter conditions will follow from the northwest. Scotland and Northern Ireland will have snow showers. Saturday, sunshine and wintry showers.
