Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
It will be a cold and frosty start to Monday with ice a particular risk for many areas of the UK. It will be predominantly dry with plenty of sunshine for most, but some wintry showers will affect Northern Ireland and also eastern and western areas of Great Britain.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Most places will be cloudy on Tuesday. A band of light rain and hill snow will move eastwards during the morning, becoming patchier as it does so. A further spell of heavier rain and strong winds will affect the UK overnight and through Wednesday morning, before clearing later in the afternoon.
