Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain in northern and eastern areas, with snow on hills, will gradually become confined to Scotland during the day. Sunny intervals will follow across England, Wales and Northern Ireland, although there will be scattered heavy, blustery showers in southern and western areas. Tonight, some rain in the far north and far south but patchy fog and frost elsewhere.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

On Saturday there will be patchy rain and sleet in the far north but early showery rain in the far south will die out. Elsewhere, dry and generally cloudy, but with some sunshine in the west. Sunday, mainly dry but rather cloudy.
