

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 16 Oct 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Scattered showers over northern Britain, some heavy for a time but also some sunny spells. Remaining areas cloudy and breezy with outbreaks of rain. The rain becoming extensive and heavy, locally very heavy, from late morning and accompanied by extensive hill fog. Temperatures a little above normal.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

On Wednesday, cloud and rain over southeastern England will clear away eastwards during the morning. Most other parts of Britain dry with good spells of sunshine though scattered showers over northwestern areas. Mostly dry on Thursday with sunny spells after any overnight fog patches clear. Temperatures near normal by day, but chilly nights.
