Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Saturday: Patchy fog and frost in southeast England will lift to bring some hazy sunshine, but may linger in parts of Scotland. Otherwise, rather cloudy over the rest of the United Kingdom with patchy rain in the northwest. Becoming milder in Northern Ireland, but staying cold under lingering fog in some Scottish areas.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Mainly dry in England, Wales and eastern Scotland with some sunshine in the northeast at first after a foggy start. Cloudy further south with patchy drizzle in far western areas. Becoming rainy in the northwest on Monday. Becoming milder in the west, near normal to rather cold towards the east and south..
