Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain will gather and spread northeastwards across much of western Britain today, especially Wales. As it spreads into northern Britain this afternoon, the rain will turn readily to sleet and snow over higher ground of Scotland and northern England. Overnight, severe gales and blizzards will affect Scotland, elsewhere the rain clearing away eastwards.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

There will be sunny intervals and blustery showers on Wednesday, the showers wintry in the north. Cloud and rain will spread to Wales Wednesday evening. On Thursday, more cloud and heavy rain spreading to all parts. Winds will be strong to gale force throughout.
