

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud and patchy drizzle in the southeast slow to clear, but otherwise much of the southern UK fine with some warm sunshine. The far northwest seeing strong winds and heavy rain. A band of cloud and rain sinking south later and continuing overnight. Staying fine in the southeast until near dawn. A few clear spells developing behind the rain band.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

A cloudy, damp start in the south on Sunday, slowly brightening up. Windy with some showery rain in the far north of Scotland. Otherwise some bright or sunny spells. Cloudy and wet in the northwest on Monday, otherwise largely fine.
