Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Patchy sleet or snow in central areas, will slowly edge southwards through the day. Snow showers in the east will blow well inland at times. Rain in the far southwest may start to turn wintry later on, especially over the Moors. Feeling bitterly cold in most places.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Snow may affect southern areas on Monday, especially during the morning, and accumulate before easing later. Snow showers in the east blowing well inland at times. Bitterly cold and windy with frost and ice. Further snow showers in the east on Tuesday, some blowing inland. Very cold and windy with frost and ice.
