

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A frosty morning for many with cloud across southern England and Wales spreading northwards and giving patchy drizzle over high ground. Plenty of sunshine in the north with a strengthening wind. Turning increasingly cloudy overnight with hill fog. Remaining cold and frosty for some, especially northwest Scotland which is likely to remain cloud free.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Tuesday will be mostly grey and murky across the UK with hill fog and patchy drizzle, although drier and brighter across parts of northwestern Scotland. Rain arriving in the west later. On Wednesday rain will clear eastwards and sunshine and showers will develop from the southwest.
