Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain will clear northwards during tomorrow morning leaving many places dry. However, scattered showers are expected to follow fairly quickly early in the afternoon, turning heavy and possibly thundery from the Midlands northwards. The southeast of England looks set to see the best of the dry and bright weather, feeling warm and humid once again.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday and Thursday will remain changeable, with sunny spells and further scattered sharp showers on Wednesday, followed by longer spells of rain on Thursday. Temperatures will start to fall closer to average though, as winds change to a fresher northwesterly by Thursday evening.
