Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud and occasionally heavy rain across Scotland, Northern Ireland, northern England and Wales will spread steadily eastwards through the day, but gradually become lighter. Warm in the southeast with some brightness until mid afternoon, Brighter in Scotland later. Breezy. Cloudy with some light rain in the south overnight, becoming drier and clearer from the northwest overnight.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Cloudy with rain spreading across Northern Ireland and western Scotland, extending to eastern Scotland and northern England later. Elsewhere warm, or very warm in southeast, with sunny spells. Mild with rain in central and southern areas on Wednesday. Brighter with showers further north.
