Headline:

Rain in north moving southeast. Many southern areas staying dry.

Today:

A lot of cloud generally. Outbreaks of rain, initially mainly in northern parts, reaching some southeastern areas later. Dry and bright in the far south, and turning drier across Scotland and Northern Ireland later.

Tonight:

Rain and drizzle continuing to sink southeastwards, mostly dying away. Otherwise generally dry but cloudy.

Outlook for Friday:

Mainly dry with some warm sunshine developing after a cloudy start.
