

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 10 Mar 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mainly cloudy, with occasional drizzle in some exposed western and especially northwestern areas, coupled with hill fog. Some warm sunny spells should develop later, particularly in eastern Britain. Overnight it will again be rather cloudy and misty in exposed western areas, with light drizzle in places. Meanwhile the east should stay largely dry with clear spells.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Although it will be rather cloudy at times, most will stay dry and mild into the new week. Most will see some sunny spells, although northwestern parts in particular may see occasional drizzle. Clearer spells overnight may allow mist patches to form in places.
