

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloudier and breezier than yesterday for most, and feeling cooler. Outbreaks of rain in the southwest, and a few showers elsewhere, wintry in the north. Overnight, rain in the far south, a few wintry showers in the far north. Otherwise, largely dry with occasional clear spells, but mainly cloudy. Remaining breezy.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Largely cloudy on Tuesday, but brighter for parts of Scotland. Rain in the south gradually clearing. A few showers elsewhere, wintry in the north. Turning increasingly unsettled from the south on Wednesday, with outbreaks of rain or showers at times, as well as some hill snow in the north.
