Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Predominantly fine and cold, with a widespread frost this morning. Sleety showers will affect the north of Scotland and the east coast of England at times. Generally frosty this evening, before rain and snow across Northern Ireland spreads eastwards across Britain through tonight. The snow can be expected from the Midland and Wales northwards, with blizzards affecting northern hills.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Becoming bright and breezy from the west on Thursday with scattered showers, though sleet and snow will persist all day in the northeast. Cold and windy on Friday with sunshine and showers; the showers most prevalent in the north and west.
