

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Wednesday 07 Mar 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Showers, some heavy, across northern and western Scotland and eastern England will gradually become lighter and less frequent. Elsewhere isolated showers, mainly light, and sunny spells. Overnight showers, a few heavy, will affect western and northern Scotland, western England and Wales. Isolated showers elsewhere, with often large amounts of cloud. Later showers dying away, except across northern Scotland.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Dry start, but increasing cloud will bring rain from the west across Northern Ireland then Scotland, and later Wales and western England. Elsewhere dry, with sunny then bright spells. Friday rain clearing east, then breezy, with sunshine and heavy showers.
