


Yellow warning

Heavy rain and strong winds will affect many southeastern areas of England today.

What to expect

- Spray and flooding is likely to result in difficult driving conditions and possible some road closures, as well as delays or cancellations to train and bus services
- Homes and businesses could be flooded, causing damage to some buildings
- Power cuts may occur, with the potential to affect other services
- Some damage to trees and other structures may occur
- Some roads and bridges may close

Further details

Heavy rain is will continue to affect southeastern parts of England today and this evening. Accumulations of 20-30 mm are likely widely, with 60-70 mm possible in places, this most likely for parts of Kent where 30-40mm has already fallen in places.

Strong winds are also likely with gusts of 45 mph inland, and gusts to around 55 mph along exposed coasts in the far E of England. Coming from an unusual (northerly) direction may increase the likelihood of wind-related impacts. Note that these winds will also lead to large waves, and spray and overtopping around some coasts.
