Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Further showers may be heavy at times, though less frequent than on Monday for many. Good sunny spells too, the best of these in the east. Breezy, but winds generally lighter than on Monday too. Overnight, showers will continue for many. Persistent rain arriving in the southeast brings a further risk of flooding. A touch of frost in sheltered north.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Lighter winds. Showers in the northwest becoming increasingly confined to the far north through Wednesday. A mainly dry start elsewhere, before persistent rain spreads northeast across England and Wales. Thursday, mainly sunny after early rain clears central and southern parts.
