

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 29 Feb 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

Rain, some heavy, spreading across western and northern areas during the morning. Dry and chilly elsewhere initially, but becoming wet this afternoon, as gales develop widely, severe in the north and northeast at times. Rain will clear southeastward overnight with showers following into northern and some western areas, wintry over Scotland. Elsewhere, dry with clear spells.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

On Saturday, there will be sunshine and showers, mainly in western and northwest areas, wintry over Scotland and easing during the day. However, rain will redevelop over most parts later. Very windy, particularly at first. Rain will slowly ease during Sunday, redeveloping later.
