Headline:

Becoming mainly dry and misty overnight. Rain spreading southeast Friday.

This Evening and Tonight:

Mainly cloudy with a little drizzle in most places, once rain gradually clears from southeast England. Mist and patchy fog will form in many areas.

Friday:

Rain spreading southeast, not reaching SE.England until evening. Colder, clearer weather will follow from the northwest, with showers developing across NW.Scotland. Ahead of the rain dry, cloudy, with mist/fog slowly lifting

Outlook for Saturday:

Sunny spells and showers.
