

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A mixture of bright spells and scattered showers across Scotland and Northern Ireland. Elsewhere, showery rain should ease across England and Wales, leaving a dry day for most with scattered showers in southern and eastern England. Overnight it should stay mostly dry with clear spells and only occasional light rain for northern Scotland. Temperatures will remain warm, with light winds.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Mostly dry with sunny spells and occasional light rain or showers on Wednesday. Rain and strong winds will spread to northwestern parts on Thursday, with the southeast hanging onto some drier and brighter weather. It will remain warm and humid.
