Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A dry, cold morning for many with frost in the northeast. A band of rain will then spread north and east to all parts through the course of the day, bringing snow to northern hills. Drier and brighter weather will return from the southwest before further heavy rain and strong winds arrive during the night.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Wednesday will be very windy for England and Wales with squally showers slowly fading. Scotland will see lighter winds but will also showery with some hill snow. Rain arriving in the Southwest on Wednesday night will spread to all parts through Thursday.
