Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A generally dry day, with variable amounts of cloud, warm sunny spells and light winds. However scattered showers are likely in places, these heaviest and most frequent in western Scotland and Northern Ireland, but also possible elsewhere. However the best of the drier and brighter weather will be in southeast England, where it will be feeling warm.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

The theme of sunny spells and showers continues, although the showers will be more frequent and also heavier at times on Wednesday. These could also be slow moving, with the risk of thunder as well. Winds are also expected to remain light.
