

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Saturday 05 Jun 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Dry and warm for most with plenty of sunshine, but scattered showers will develop from mid-morning, these turning heavy and perhaps thundery across Northern Ireland, eastern Scotland and eastern England through the afternoon. The showers merge and linger overnight across Northern Ireland and northern England, whilst heavy, persistent and thundery rain affects the far Southeast towards dawn.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Most places will see showers or longer spells of rain at times through Sunday, these again becoming heavy and thundery, especially across East Anglia and northwestern parts of Scotland. It remains unsettled through Monday with temperatures returning to near normal.
