

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Thursday 25 Oct 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Southern parts largely cloudy with intermittent drizzle or light rain, and less mild than recently. Becoming breezy in the far south and southwest. Further north, clearer, colder conditions with some sunshine will spread southwards, reaching central England and Wales by dawn. It will be a cold night, with northern and northeastern coastal districts seeing occasional wintry showers.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday bright and clear but generally breezy. Wintry showers affecting coastal districts in the north and east, but most other places dry with plenty of sunshine. Feeling cold. Saturday still fine in the south, but wet and windy weather spreading across northern areas.
